## ***Meetings & Workshops***

**Mactoberfest:** Held each October, it is the most popular HMAUS function. This all day event includes vendor presentations, workshops, help clinics, computer swap meet, door prizes and more.

**MacSpringfest:** Held each March or April, it is the second most popular HMAUS function. This all day event includes vendor presentations, workshops, help clinics, computer swap meet, student photography contest, door prizes and more.

**HOTS:** Hands on Training Seminars are held each first and third Saturday of each month. Students learn how to use hardware and software in workshop series of one more workshops per seminar. Internet and wireless networking is used so that students will be able to follow and do exercises on their laptops. Class sizes are small and registration is required. Workshops may require fees to cover the cost of materials.

**MacLearn:** Monthly presentations held on the fourth Saturday of each month. This lecture style meeting introduces and demonstrates new software, hardware and resources.

**Brown Bag Fixit Clinic:** A monthly help and fixit clinic on the second Thursday evening each month. Members get together to help each other diagnose hardware and software problems.
